

**SUWANNEE COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT
MEETING MINUTES
July 19, 2018**

The Suwannee County Conservation District Board of Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting Thursday, July 19, 2018 at the USDA-Service Center. Supervisors attending the meeting included: Andy Jackson, Chairman; James Williams, Secretary/Treasurer; Terry Reagan, Supervisor; De Broughton, Supervisor; and Ronnie Lawson, Supervisor. Also attending was: Garrett McCray, SCCD Administrator; Joni Fortner, SCCD Staff Assistant; Ryan Lawson, Conservation Technician; Chris Menhennett, District Conservationist (NRCS); Larry Sessions, Suwannee County Board of County Commissioners; and Joel Love, BMP Education Coordinator (UF/IFAS).

Chairman, Andy Jackson, called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. James Williams motioned for those minutes to be approved. This motion was seconded by Terry Reagan.

The Financial Reports were reviewed. Terry Reagan motioned to approve those reports. This motion was seconded by James Williams.

AFCD has requested to have an item donated for the auction to be held at their Annual State Meeting in Ocala. The Board agreed on a maximum value of \$100. James Williams motioned to approve this. The motion was seconded by Ronnie Lawson.

Garrett McCray, SCCD Administrator, went over the BMP Contract numbers. There's approximately \$80,000 remaining to be paid out to producers, which must be completed by September 1st.

Ryan Lawson, SCCD Conservation Technician, gave his District Activity Report. He stated that he has been working on completing the BMP cost share for 2017-2018, and is beginning the 2018-2019 year. Ryan attended the technicians' meeting in Quincy where it was mentioned that they would now be required to submit all NOI's within 2 weeks of having them signed, as well as having their monthly logs and reports completed on a monthly basis for their meetings.

Chris Menhennett, NRCS District Conservationist, gave an update on the programs being administered through NRCS. He stated that they are still in the process of funding EQIP contracts.

Joel Love, BMP Education Coordinator, stated that William McGehee has completed his SBR Program, and SCCD has made the final payment to him. He also mentioned some upcoming events being held such as the Sunbelt Expo, the Corn Lunch & Learn, and the Peanut Demo.



The next District Meeting will be held August 16, 2018.


OTHER BUSINESS:
