

**SUWANNEE COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT  
MEETING MINUTES**

**March 17, 2022**

**The Suwannee County Conservation District Board of Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting Thursday, March 17, 2022 at the UF/IFAS Extension Office, Exhibit Hall II. Supervisors attending were Andy Jackson, Chairman; Ronnie Lawson, Vice Chairman; and Larry Sessions, Supervisor.**

**Also attending were Joni Sapp, SCCD Staff Assistant; Garrett McCray, SCCD Administrator; Amy Smith, NRCS District Conservationist; Tiffany Smith, SCCD Conservation Technician; John Garrison, SCCD Conservation Technician; Tyler Dasilva, Madison County SWCD Conservation Technician; and Joel Love, UF/IFAS BMP Education Coordinator.**

**Chairman, Andy Jackson, called the meeting to order at 7:05p.m.**

**The Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. Larry Sessions motioned for those minutes to be approved. This motion was seconded by Ronnie Lawson.**

**Amy Smith, NRCS District Conservationist, gave an update on NRCS activities. She stated that they are currently working on ranking and assessments to meet the deadline of March 28, 2022. She also presented the new MOA/UCA for Andy Jackson to sign.**

**Joel Love, UF/IFAS BMP Education Coordinator, discussed the 5-year Cover Crop Demo that is nearing the end. He also discussed the possibility of having a farm tour in May including FDACS and NRCS. Joel reminded everyone of the upcoming CARES Dinner on May 5, 2022.**

**Andy Jackson will sign the updated NRCS MOA/UCA.**

**The Board has agreed to not have the Annual Awards Banquet this year, in hopes of being able to next year.**

**The Board discussed the NACD/NRCS TA2022 Grant. It was agreed upon to apply with a 20% increase to the previous four years.**

**NEW BUSINESS:**


