

**SUWANNEE COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT
MEETING MINUTES**

September 8, 2022

The Suwannee County Conservation District Board of Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting Thursday, September 8, 2022 at The USDA Service Center located at 1525-B Ohio Avenue South in Live Oak. Supervisors attending were Andy Jackson, Chairman; Ronnie Lawson, Vice Chairman; James Williams, Secretary/Treasurer; Terry Reagan, Supervisor; and Larry Sessions, Supervisor.

Also attending were Joni Sapp, SCCD Staff Assistant; Garrett McCray, SCCD Administrator; Amy Smith, NRCS District Conservationist; and John Garrison, SCCD Conservation Technician.

Chairman, Andy Jackson, called the meeting to order at 7:01p.m.

The Minutes of the previous meeting held August 18, 2022 were reviewed. James Williams motioned for those minutes to be approved. This motion was seconded by Terry Reagan.

The Financial Reports were reviewed. Larry Sessions motioned to approve those reports. This motion was seconded by Ronnie Lawson.

Garrett McCray, SCCD Administrator, discussed our current contracts. For BMP Tools, we have approximately \$390,000 obligated with (14) CSA's. RESTORE Energy has approximately \$345,000 obligated and RESTORE BMP has approximately \$400,000.

For the FDACS Cover Crop contract, we have approximately \$27,000 remaining to be spent, and approximately \$22,000 remaining of Stetson Cover Crop funds.

Amy Smith, NRCS District Conservationist, gave an update on NRCS activities. She stated that they continue to work on FY 2022 preapprovals, which currently consists of (21) contracts totaling approximately \$1,500,000. She mentioned that the FY 2023 application deadline has been extended to September 30, 2022. Amy also discussed RCPP Nutrient Management and stated the deadline of October 31, 2022.

Technician John Garrison continues working on NOI's, IV's, and BMP cost share

The next District Meeting will be held Thursday October 13, 2022.


OTHER BUSINESS:
